

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (EP) ACT 1986 AND ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION AND BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION (EPBC) ACT REFERRALS - Q2 2025

To the WA Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) and Commonwealth Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (DCCEEW).



By EPA and DCCEEW, RES is likely to seek bilateral assessment pathway which will allow the Commonwealth to assess the Project using the EPA documentation.

CONDUCT REQUIRED STUDIES

RES will complete any additional studies requested through the referral process.

LODGE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW DOCUMENT (ERD)

With the EPA, which will address assessment requirements under the EPBC Act.

PUBLIC REVIEW

The EPA places the ERD on public exhibition if required as part of assessment process.

Community, Councils and State agencies can make submissions.

RESPONSE TO SUBMISSIONS

RES prepares Submissions Report that explains how submissions have been addressed by the Project.

EPA REPORT WITH RECOMMENDATIONS AND DRAFT CONDITIONS

Submitted to the Minister for the Environment and released to the public.

DECISION ON APPROVAL AND FINAL MINISTERIAL STATEMENT

By WA Minister for Environment for the EP Act approval and by Commonwealth Minister for the Environment for the EPBC approval.

PLANNING APPROVAL

The Project will require development approval under the WA Planning and Development Act
